- Acting responsibly, in compliance with environmental, occupational health and safety legislation by preventing all forms of illicit and/or crime in the matter.
- Adhering to the voluntary standards UNI EN ISO9001:2015, UNI EN ISO14001:2015, ISO/IEC 27001:2017, UNI ISO 45001 and UNI PdR 125:2022 by complying and applying their requirements
- With particular attention to the areas affected by the risk of crimes and/or offences, analyze one's internal and external processes, products and services, identifying areas for potential improvement and setting objectives and targets
- Specifically eliminate where possible or further minimize occupational health and safety hazards such as: manual handling of loads, repetitive movements, noise and vibration, electrical and chemical hazards
- Reducing environmental impacts by preventing all forms of illicit in this regard, directly or indirectly, permanently or occasionally, operate in collaboration with or on behalf of the company (suppliers, contractors and subcontractors) focusing particularly on the prevention of light pollution, improvement of the working environment
- Maintaing a proactive role of management in promoting continuous improvement in matters covered by the integrated management system in order to prevent crimes and/or offenses
- Ensuring the proper application of the technologies used and, where possible, pursuing the improvement or adoption of more advanced technologies from an environmental and safety perspective by working to ensure that the standards governing these aspects are known
- Insight into environmental, occupational health and safety assessments in decisions regarding future developments in order to prevent all forms of illicit and/or criminal offenses
- Ensuring the participation and co-responsibility of all employees, for the full sharing of company policy and objectives, for the development of a culture oriented on gender equality, inclusion, prevention and maintenance of safe-working conditions. - Through context analysis and SWOT analysis referring to the Integrated Quality Environment and Safety System identifies external, internal risks and opportunities.
- Through the risk matrix, evaluate risks and opportunities by placing the necessary countermeasures to strengthen weaknesses and respond to possible threats, with the view to continuous improvement
- Through VERA assesses information security risks and devises countermeasures to reduce the risk.
